Number of Vacancies: 01

Research, Training and Management (RTM) International NGO working in the Cox's Bazar to implement different projects supported by Government of Bangladesh, UNFPA, UNICEF and others development partners. To provide essential health services to the affected population in different location RTM requires to fill up vacancies in the mentioned position.

Job Responsibilities:

1. Conduct deliveries in the birthing units, providing skilled, supportive and compassionate care to laboring patients.
2. Deliver nursing and midwifery services within the Delivery Unit, ensuring the comfort, safety, and dignity of patients during the birthing process.
3. Provide intensive care and implement appropriate interventions for patients requiring referral from the Birthing Units to higher-level facilities.
4. Administer antenatal care (ANC) and postnatal care (PNC) services, closely monitoring the health and well-being of mothers and newborns.
5. Conduct group, family, and individual counselling sessions to raise awareness about pregnancy and childbirth complications.
6. Provide specialized counselling to patients and their families, focusing on risk factors and preparing for potential complications.
7. Promote informed decision-making among family members, emphasizing the importance of birth preparedness and smooth transition from shelter to birthing units.
8. Mentor, monitor, and validate the work of Community Health Workers (CHWs), ensuring accurate and reliable information is shared with pregnant mothers.
9. Regularly report and update the Medical Officer on the condition of pregnant mothers to support effective decision-making.
10. Support and ensure the quality of care within the Birthing Unit, contributing to safe, effective, and patient-centered healthcare services.
11. Supervise the activities of support staff in the Birthing Unit, including cleaners and guards, to maintain a clean, safe, and infection-free environment.
12. Ensure instruments, equipment, and supplies are available, functional, and in a state of readiness for safe and effective patient care.



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13. Maintain accurate and comprehensive records and registers within the Birthing Unit, ensuring proper documentation and reporting.
14. Maintain and follow the standard guidelines of Infection and Prevention Control (IPC) of the assigned facility.
15. Maintain close communication and work as per the guidance of the Head of Operations – Field, Medical Coordinator, and Medical Officer-In-Charge.
16. Know, understand, and comply with all the policies of RTM International, including HR Policy, PSEA, Code of Conduct and Workplace policy.
17. Perform any additional tasks as assigned by the authority to support the efficient functioning of the healthcare facility.
